Resolution 2018-R-10

Adopting a Statement of Consistency with Adopted Plans in Reference to ZTA-2018-02, Creedmoor Development Ordinance Article 21

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Creedmoor has received the Planning Department staff report, a recommendation from the Planning Board, and has reviewed the comments received from the Planning Board in reference to ZTA-2018-02; and

WHEREAS, Under NCGS§ 160A-383, the following procedures must be followed: *“Zoning regulations shall be made in accordance with a comprehensive plan. When adopting or rejecting any zoning amendment, the governing board shall also approve a statement describing whether its action is consistent with an adopted comprehensive plan...and briefly explaining why the board considers the action taken to be reasonable and in the public interest. That statement is not subject to judicial review.”* And,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners conducted the statutorily required advertised public hearing in accordance with the State of North Carolina’s General Statutes during the course of the regularly scheduled monthly meeting on June 5, 2018; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that The City of Creedmoor Board of Commissioners finds that the petitioners’ request to amend the Creedmoor Development Ordinance, Article 21 OPEN SPACE is fully consistent with the City of Creedmoor CITY PLAN 2030’s City Policies; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the action undertaken by the Board of Commissioners is both reasonable and in the public interest as it will further the goal stated in CITY PLAN 2030 of expanding recreational opportunities, both active and passive, to serve the needs of all citizens, and will clarify City expectations for open space improvements in new developments.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Creedmoor adopts this consistency statement and considers the Zoning Text Amendment-2018-02 to be both reasonable and in the public interest.
