
RESOLUTION 2020-R-01:

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR CENSUS 2020


- Whereas,** the U.S. Census Bureau is required by the U.S. Constitution to conduct a count of the population and provides a historic opportunity to help shape the foundation of our society and play an active role in American democracy; and
- Whereas,** the City of Creedmoor is committed to ensuring every resident is counted; and
- Whereas,** federal and state funding is allocated to communities, and decisions are made on matters of national and local importance based, in part, on census data and housing; and
- Whereas,** census data helps determine how many seats each state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives as well as to determine other state and local legislative, school, and voting districts; and
- Whereas,** information from the 2020 Census and American Community Survey are vital tools for economic development and increased employment; and
- Whereas,** the information collected by the census is confidential and protected by law; and
- Whereas,** the City of Creedmoor supports the efforts of the Granville County Complete Count Committee and the Kerr-Tar Regional Council of Governments Complete Count Committee, which will bring together a cross section of community members who will utilize their local knowledge and expertise to reach out to all persons of our community in order to achieve an accurate count of Creedmoor citizens.

Now therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Creedmoor supports the efforts of the U.S. Census Bureau, the State of North Carolina, Granville County, and the Kerr-Tar Regional Council of Governments and that the City of Creedmoor will assist with the implementation of a census awareness campaign designed to maximize participation in the 2020 United States Census.
