

MINUTES OF CITY OF CREEDMOOR BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS CLOSED SESSION OCTOBER 2, 2018 5:30 p.m.

PRESENT

Mayor Bobby Wheeler, Mayor Pro Tem Archer Wilkins, Commissioner Del Mims, Commissioner Herman Wilkerson, Commissioner Neena Nowell, Commissioner Ernie Anderson. Also present were Interim City Manager Korena Weichel, City Clerk Kathleen McCorkle, and Attorney T.C. Morphis Jr.

Attorney TC Morphis reported that the purchase of the McGuinness property is headed to closing.

Regarding the Peace property at Lake Rogers, a 30-day intent-to-condemn letter was mailed September 4, with no response received from Mr. Peace. Moved by Commissioner Anderson to proceed with eminent domain; seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Wilkins. The motion received a 4-1 vote with Commissioner Mims dissenting.

Redacted – Personnel discussion

Regarding the continued letters received from Freedom from Religion regarding separating the Christmas story reading from the city's tree lighting, Mayor Pro Tem Wilkins moved that the Christmas story no longer be advertised or read as part of the tree lighting ceremony; seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion received a 5-0 vote.

It was reported that Diana Dudley still hasn't signed the property purchase agreement, although she has no objections to the agreement.

Moved by Mayor Pro Tem Wilkins to return to open session; seconded by Commissioner Wilkerson. The motion received a 5-0 vote.
