

MINUTES OF CITY OF CREEDMOOR BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MAY 12, 2021 6 P.M.

Call to Order

Mayor Wheeler called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Commissioner Brustmeyer-Brown offered the invocation, and Commissioner Kicinski led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call

Roll call by the City Clerk determined a quorum was present.

South Granville Senior Center Lease

City Manager Gerald Smith presented an updated draft of the lease agreement for the South Granville Senior Center. The draft has been updated in consultation with County Manager Michael Felts and reviewed by City Attorney T.C. Morphis and County Attorney James Wrenn. The staff of both the City of Creedmoor and Granville County has agreed in principle to the terms of the agreement, pending approval by the respective governing Boards. Smith reported that staff has proposed the installation of a gate that would allow access to areas adjacent to the Senior Center by the City of Creedmoor when Senior Services are not occupying the space while allaying security concerns for unstaffed areas of the facility. Both parties have reached an agreement to have Granville County pay a flat fee of \$6,200 for the first year's utility usage, and then recalculate the appropriate amount once we have a full year of utility data and find the correct payment based on the 15% of square footage occupied Granville County. City Attorney T.C. Morphis explained why the lease was for ten years instead of a longer-term, which is mostly because leasing city-owned property for more than ten years requires going through the upset bid process and operates much like a property sale.

Commissioner Kicinski moved to approve the lease agreement with Granville County Senior Services to lease space at the Creedmoor Community Center as presented. The motion was approved by roll call vote 5-0.
