What is a Parkstrip?


The area along public streets and avenues between the curb line (or edge of the roadway if no curb line is present) and the sidewalk line (or property line if no sidewalk is present).

What do I need to do?

In short, maintain the parkstrip as you would care for your lawn. Keep the grass trimmed and the area clear of dirt, grass, weeds, mud, trash, debris and vegetation of any kind to prevent a hazard to the public. If you have a drainage swale, keep it free of leaf and limb debris along with mowing and trimming the area so the swale continues to serve its proper drainage function.
