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## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **Numbering of Houses, Apartments, and Trailer Parks**

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Creedmoor, during their regular legislative meeting on April 5, 2022, motioned to approve a zoning text amendment to *Article 2 General Provisions* of the Creedmoor Development Ordinance. The addition of *Article 2.23- Numbering of Houses, Apartments, and Trailer Parks* adds language on addressing of property. The City of Creedmoor is currently updating its technical standards manual, which will provide additional detail on addressing.

The property owner must correctly display the address assigned to a structure or lot, whether numerical or alphanumeric, known as the Unit Identification (UI). On a private home, this UI shall be placed either above or immediately alongside the front entrance to the structure and clearly visible from the street. If a central cluster postal box site is provided, the assigned lot/site UI also shall be displayed on the individual boxes of the cluster. The structure may be marked according to division if the mobile home rests on a permanent foundation.

The amortization period of three hundred sixty-five (365) days from the date of approval, ends on April 5, 2023. Residents are asked to review the addressing of their property and make changes by April 5, 2023, if not already clearly marked. Residents do not need to obtain a sign permit for addressing purposes. Ensuring that your property has clear addressing on the building will help public safety in the event of an emergency.
