Resolution 2023-R-12 RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO CONSIDER AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CREEDMOOR SUCH THAT A MAYOR SHALL BE ELECTED EVERY FOUR YEARS

Whereas, the Section 3.2 of the Charter of the City of Creedmoor (the "Charter") establishes that a mayor shall be elected in the regular municipal election every two (2) years; and

Whereas, the City of Creedmoor Board of Commissioners (the "BOC") desire to amend the Charter to establish that a mayor shall be elected in the regular municipal election every four (4) years; and

Whereas, N.C. Gen. Stat. § 160A-102 requires the BOC to adopt a resolution of intent to consider an ordinance amending the charter, which resolution shall describe the proposed charter amendments briefly but completely and with reference to the pertinent provisions of G.S. 160A-101, but it need not contain the precise text of the charter amendments necessary to implement the proposed changes.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City of Creedmoor Board of Commissioners the following:

- Section 1. The BOC does hereby adopt this Resolution and states its intent to consider an ordinance amending the Charter such that a mayor shall be elected every four (4) years instead of every two (2) years pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 160A-101(8)(a.).
- Section 2. The BOC shall, at the same time as this Resolution is adopted, call a public hearing on the proposed Charter amendment, which hearing shall be not more than forty five (45) days after the adoption of this Resolution.
- Section 3. The BOC shall cause a notice of the hearing to be published at least once not less than 10 days prior to the date fixed for the public hearing, and said notice shall contain a summary of the proposed amendments.
- Section 4. Following the public hearing, but not earlier than the next regular meeting of the BOC and not later than 60 days from the date of the hearing, the BOC may adopt an ordinance amending the Charter to implement the amendments proposed in this Resolution.
